




Depending on your chosen program, you'll get to experience Brazilian culture through unforgettable activities like these:




Step into one of Latin America's

Hop on a double-decker bus and explore Curitiba's lush parks, charming groves, and bustling central squares — a perfect way to see the city from a whole new perspective!




Shopping Spree:

The Famous Train Ride to Morretes
Embark on a breathtaking journey aboard the iconic
Paranaguá–Curitiba Railway, hailed as Brazil's most scenic
train ride. Travel through lush Atlantic Forest landscapes,
crossing 41 bridges and passing through 13 tunnels while
marveling at panoramic views of mountains, rivers,
waterfalls, cliffs, and deep gorges.

Once in Morretes and Antonina, stroll through charming colonial streets steeped in Portuguese influence. Indulge in the region's authentic flavors with a hearty serving of barreado (a traditional slow-cooked beef stew), a sip of local Morretes cachaça, and the sweet taste of banana-based treats made by local artisans.
